

# ARCHBISHOP MURPHY HIGH SCHOOL WINS 2A SCHOLASTIC CUP

Archbishop Murphy High School has won the 2009-2010 2A Scholastic Cup, the WIAA's most prestigious annual school award.

As noted on the [WIAA website](#):

"The WIAA Scholastic Cup recognizes performance in the classroom as well as on the playing surface. Schools that finish at the top of their respective classifications in state athletic competition receive points, as do schools that finish at the top in team academic performance. Sportsmanship is also a factor, with substantial points deducted for ejections from contests. At the end of the year, the school with the most points in their classification will be awarded the prestigious Scholastic Cup!"

AMHS had four 2A State Academic Champions this year: Girls' Swimming with a team GPA of 3.718; Choir with a group GPA of 3.659; Softball with a team GPA of 3.762 and Boys' Golf with a team GPA of 3.635. Each of those contributed 100 points to the AMHS Scholastic Cup total. In addition, the Girls' Soccer state championship in November earned the school 100 points. As Ms. Adsit named each team and their points earned, members of those teams stood up in the bleachers. By the end of the roll call, every AMHS student was standing, cheering each other on for their great accomplishment.
